

CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE AND RELIEF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT, 2021

HIGHLIGHTS

Paycheck Protection Program Second Draw Loans

- Creates second round of PPP loans for eligible businesses.
- Defines eligibility for the PPP second draw as small businesses that have no more than 300 employees and demonstrate at least a 25 percent reduction in gross revenues between comparable quarters in 2019 and 2020.
- Borrowers receive full loan forgiveness if they spend at least 60 percent of their PPP second draw loan on payroll costs over a time period of their choosing between 8 weeks and 24 weeks.
- Includes set-asides to support first-time PPP borrowers with 10 or fewer employees, second-time PPP borrowers with 10 or fewer employees, first-time PPP borrowers who have been made newly eligible, and second-time returning PPP borrowers. Additionally, provides for a set-aside for loans made by community lenders.

Economic Aid to Hard-Hit Small Businesses, Nonprofits, and Venues Act

- **Paycheck Protection Program Second Draw Loans** -- \$284.45 billion for the Paycheck Protection Program Second Draw Loans
- **Minority Business Development Centers** -- \$25 million for Minority Business Development Centers under the Minority Business Development Agency to assist minority business enterprises with technical assistance, such as applying for PPP.
- **PPP Auditing and Fraud** -- \$50 million to SBA for PPP auditing and fraud mitigation purposes.
- **Support for Venues** – Establishes a \$15 billion grant program to support shuttered live venues, theaters, museums, and zoos that have experienced significant revenue losses.
- **Economic Injury Disaster Loan Advance Program** – \$20 billion for the EIDL Advance program, of which \$20 million is for the SBA Inspector General.

Unemployment Assistance

- **Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (FPUC)** – Provides unemployed individuals an additional \$300 per week for 10 weeks from Dec. 26, 2020 to March 14, 2021.
- **Program Extensions** – Extends and phases-out Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA), Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC), and Unemployment Insurance (UI).
- **Integrity Provisions** – Adds program integrity provisions to require documentation of earnings and employment (versus just self-certification), and requires states to have processes for verifying applicants identity, to combat fraud and abuse in the unemployment programs.

American Agriculture

- **U.S. Agriculture Support** – \$11.187 billion for the Office of the Secretary of Agriculture to provide support for agricultural producers, processors, and contract growers impacted by COVID-19, including:
 - Supplemental payments to row crop and livestock producers.
 - Payments to contract growers of poultry and livestock affected by canceled or delayed contract.
 - \$1.5 billion for food and seafood purchases.
 - \$200 million to provide relief to timber harvesting and timber hauling businesses for certain revenue losses.
 - Authorizes the Secretary to extend the terms of marketing loans.

Health and Human Services

- **Vaccine Distribution** – \$8.75 billion to plan, prepare for, promote, distribute, administer, monitor, and track coronavirus vaccines to ensure broad-based distribution, access, and vaccine coverage.
- **COVID-19 Research** – \$1.15 billion for research and clinical trials related to long-term studies of COVID-19 at the National Institutes of Health.

Department of Education

- **Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Fund** – \$54.3 billion
- **Higher Education Emergency Relief (HEER) Fund** – \$22.7 billion
- **Governors Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund** – \$4.1 billion
