(commonly known as the "Byrne JAG grant program") or section 1701 of title I of such Act (34 U.S.C. 10381) (commonly known as the "COPS grant program"), to a local government whose district attorney directs its prosecutors to not prosecute certain violent offenses or serious offenses that result in damage or injury to the property of any other person, by the amounts provided in such legislation for those purposes, provided that such legislation would not increase the deficit over either the period of the total of fiscal years

2022 through 2026 or the period of the total of fiscal

years 2022 through 2031.
