1 ference reports relating to adjustments to Federal funds
2 for local governments within the jurisdiction of the com-
3 mittees receiving reconciliation instructions under section
4 2001, which may include limiting or eliminating Federal
5 payments, other than funding under subpart 1 of part E
6 of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets
7 Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. 10151 et seq.) (commonly known
8 as the “Byrne JAG grant program”) or section 1701 of
9 title I of such Act (34 U.S.C. 10381) (commonly known
10 as the “COPS grant program”), to a local government
11 whose district attorney directs its prosecutors to not pros-
12 ecute certain violent offenses or serious offenses that re-
13 sult in damage or injury to the property of any other per-
14 son, by the amounts provided in such legislation for those
15 purposes, provided that such legislation would not increase
16 the deficit over either the period of the total of fiscal years
17 2022 through 2026 or the period of the total of fiscal
18 years 2022 through 2031.
