3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Preserving the Readi-
- 5 ness of our Armed Forces Act of 2022".

SEC. 2. ACCESS TO PAY AND BENEFITS FOR MEMBERS OF
 NATIONAL GUARD AND RESERVE COMPO NENTS WHILE REQUESTS FOR RELIGIOUS
 AND HEALTH ACCOMMODATIONS ARE PEND ING.

A member of the National Guard or another reserve
component of the Armed Forces shall maintain access to
pay and benefits while a request of the member for a religious or health accommodation is pending.

10SEC. 3. LIMITATION ON INVOLUNTARY SEPARATION OF11MEMBERS OF ARMED FORCES BASED ON12COVID-19 VACCINATION STATUS.

13 A member of an active or reserve component of the 14 Armed Forces may not be involuntarily separated from the 15 Armed Forces based solely on the vaccination status of 16 the member with respect to COVID-19 until the Armed 17 Forces have achieved the end strengths authorized under 18 the most recent Act authorizing appropriations for mili-19 tary activities of the Department of Defense.
