3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Whole Milk for5 Healthy Kids Act of 2023".

6 SEC. 2. WHOLE MILK PERMISSIBLE.

7 Section 9(a)(2) of the Richard B. Russell National
8 School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1758(a)(2)(A)) is amend9 ed—
